Facts and questions about the so-called Kuttenberg double gulden II

This study is focused on more aspects of appearance of the so-called Kuttenberg double gulden, a commemorative coin struck under the penultimate Habsburg Emperor Franz Joseph I in 1887 celebrating re-opening of the Kuttenberg silver mines in central Bohemia. The monetary context is described first—when the double gulden was produced and what was the character of the Austrian commemorative coins. Then, the way of recording number of produced coins is dealt, and problems with real number of these coins (and other pieces struck under Franz Joseph I) are discussed. Technical parameters of the coin are described, plus tests of its fineness and pieces struck in other metals are mentioned. Finally, the existing replicas of this rare and popular coin are listed.
