## Gold medal by Manfredini celebrating coronation of the Emperor Ferdinand in Milan in 1838

Gold medal by Manfredini celebrating coronation of the Emperor Ferdinand in Milan in 1838 came to the National Museum together with the collection of the assassinated successor to the throne Franz Ferdinand d'Este. The medal made of the precious metal was intended for the diplomatic corps. Some twenty four medals have been struck in gold, and one hundred and twenty three in silver. In 1839, engraving of the medal was incorporated by Alessandro Sanquirico (1777–1849) to the exclusive picture album showing rich coronation decorations designed by him for the dome in Milan. Besides many draperies and flags, there were also large medallions of the preceding rulers in Milan hanging over the tribunes for guests.
