New data on the coin board from Vlašim (Benešov district)

Bohemian and Meissen bracteates are represented in the coin board found in Vlašim in 1846. The Meissen specimens were struck approximately between 1210 and 1235, i. e. during the rule of Dietrich the Oppressed (1197–1221) and Heinrich the Enlightened (1221/1230–1288). The Bohemian coins were produced probably between 1226/1228 and 1235. These bracteates were struck in the last years of Přemysl I Otakar as the King of Bohemia (1198–1230), and during the rule of his successor, Wenceslas I (1230–1253). The board was buried some time after 1235.
