An unknown variety of the Prague grossus struck under Vladislav II Jagiellon

This study points to existence of a new variety of the Prague grossus produced at the end of the rule of Vladislav II Jagiellon. The coin – by its fabric – is directly connected to the coinage of his descendant. This new variety is primarily characterized by the crown image on obverse and placement of the division mark at the beginning of the reverse marginal legend.
