Prague grossus struck under Vladislaus II Jagiellon showing lion with mane represented by atypically placed crescents

Description of the Prague grossus struck under Vladislaus II Jagiellon is presented. There is an image of lion with mane of atypically placed crescents on its reverse. Three varieties of image and marginal legend on obverse are shown. There is an analysis and comparison of these grossi with typology and chronology by J. Hásková and other sources presented in the article. Incorporation of these grossi into the recently accepted typology and chronology is suggested at the end of the article.
