Copying of the Bohemian government coins in the 16th century

The article is dedicated to problems of copying of the Bohemian government coins by other minting authorities in the 16th century and to appearance of these coins in the local hoards. The Diepholz pfennigs have been studied above all. They came to Bohemia during the rule of Vladislaus II Jagiellon (1471–1516) and copied the white coins of the mentioned ruler. Also poor imitations of white grossi were produced in Frinco domain owned by the Mazzetti family (north Italy) during the rule of Rudolph II (1576–1611).
