
Odraz první pozemkové reformy na chmelových známkách. Známky zbytkových statků

Reflection of the land reform in case of the hop tokens. The tokens of the remnant estates.

The article is focused on the hop tokens used during hop harvest for evidence of work in the remnant estates in the Žatec (Saaz) region. Existence of these tokens is limited by interval of 1919–1938. They document national and property changes in the Žatec hop region caused by the Czechoslovak land reform of 1919. The tokens were produced by the workshop of Rudolf Lässig in Žatec and the Prague company of Karnet and Kyselý. The published tokens represent production of this commodity between the beginning of the 1920s and 1930s. The tokens of A. Kočárek from Divice have been struck by both companies, and they document copying tokens of the rival workshop in Žatec.
