Copy of the white grossus struck under Rudolph II at the Frinco Manor

Probably an unknown copy of the white grossus struck under Rudolph II (1576–1611) at the Frinco Manor (north Italy) is discussed. Low quality copies of various coins were produced there by the Mazzetti in 1581–1601. Besides of the copy of the white grossus, also one specimen bearing the name of the Emperor Rudolph II in its marginal legend has been discovered. Such coin has not been listed in the actual catalogues yet.
