Two unpublished Silesian coins struck under Leopold I

These two coins represent middle denominations: a 6-kreuzer struck in Opole in 1679 (the mint-master Franz Ignaz Kürschenbofer) and a 3-kreuzer struck in Brzeg in 1697 (the mint-master Christoph Brettschneider). Production of the Silesian mints was quite massive in 1673–1705, and only few types of the marginal legends were used in case of the mentioned denominations. The individual types described in the book by Halačka can be derived via combination of obverse and reverse marginal legends. Some combinations seem to remain non-described, but they will probably appear in the public or private collections.
