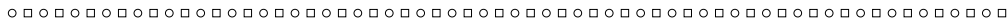

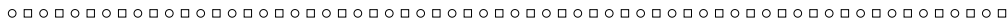

Commemorative coins issued in 2010

The Czech National Bank issued seven coins in 2010. The following 200 CZK silver pieces were struck: 600th anniversary of construction of the Astronomical Clock in Prague's Old Town, 150th birth anniversary of composer Gustav Mahler; 150th birth anniversary of painter Alfons Mucha, 700th anniversary of marriage of John of Luxembourg to Elisabeth of Bobemia and 100th birth anniversary of director Karel Zeman. Special issues in the series called Cultural Monuments of the Technological Heritage were represented by the following monuments: Heritage Site – Hammer Mill at Dobřív and National Heritage Site – Michal Mine in Ostrava. Also two emissions in gold were produced this year, in denomination of 2,500 CZK.
