Nedatovaný pražský groš Ferdinanda I. s atypicky provedenou korunou

Undated Prague grossus struck under Ferdinand I with atypical crown

An undated Prague grossus struck under Ferdinand I, the Holy Roman Emperor, with atypical crown is presented. The mentioned crown — in spite of the fact that it shows all features typical for arch crowns — has no arch on the top of the coin image. The coin is a mule of Ferdinand's obverse and reverse struck from dies used for coins of Louis I in Kuttenberg. Because of the presented facts, the coin — from the chronological point of view — could be classified among the very first Prague grossi with titulature of Ferdinand I, i.e. at the beginning of 1527 very likely.
