An unrecorded 6-kreuzer piece struck under Leopold I in the Breslau mint

The 6-kreuzer piece by the Breslau mint-master M. M. Wackerl struck in 1693 (MKČ 1611b) has not been registered in the numismatic literature yet. It differs by its reverse and obverse marginal legends from other types produced in 1693 under the mentioned mint-master (the 6-kreuzer pieces MKČ 1608, 1612 and 1610b). Great variability of the reverse and obverse legends seems to be the common reason for existence of these unrecorded specimens.
