Zaujímavý grošový nález zo 14. storočia zo Slovenska. Príspevok k spoločnému obehu uhorských a pražských grošov

An interesting board of grossi of the 14th century found in Slovakia. Contribution to the common circulation of the Hungarian and Prague grossi

In 2009, three Hungarian grossi and one Prague grossus were found between Čataj and Boldrog (Senec district, Slovakia). The hoard was buried in 1334–1336 very likely, and it represents a very important illustration of the common circulation of coins of both types in Hungary. It is a very interesting phenomenon, because production of the grossi in Hungary also started in order to eliminate the Prague grossi from circulation. The grossi were struck in Hungary in 1329-1338, and later on, also after 1345. The ratio was approximately 8 Hungarian grossi to 7 Prague grossi.
