Two new finds of the Gaulish coins from borderland of central and south Bohemia

In the 2010s, two Gaulish coins were found in borderland of central and south Bohemia. One quarter stater (DT 2533-2535) struck in the western part of central Gaul between the 2nd century BC and the beginning of the 1st century BC was found in Zalužany (central Bohemia, Příbram district). Another quarter stater (DT 180) produced very likely under the Remi in 90/80-50 BC was discovered near Probulov (south Bohemia, Písek district). Both coins can indicate import to central Europe via contacts of the local people on the old Gold Road with the Mediterranean regions, and also with some areas in western Europe in the La Tène period (LTC – LTD).
